Students seeking EC-12 Art Teacher Certification are required to take these specific courses for their Area Requirements, such as ART 310K, ART 311K, ART 315K, or ART 316K. Grades for any course taken through correspondence <u>must</u> be on file in SZB 216 (George Sanchez Bldg.) before the start of the student teaching semester. Students must have a cumulative UT GPA of 3.00 and a cumulative ARH, ART, VAS GPA of 3.0 to remain eligible for PDS application, interview, and certification.
