**Texas Musical Theatre Workshop in Austin, TX** is seeking a team of energetic Residential Supervisors for its summer intensive program, June 10 – 30, 2012 on The University of Texas at Austin campus. Residential Supervisors will attend, assist, and implement all TMTW activities, including but not limited to: staff orientations, student check-in, voice and dance studio classes, master classes led by Broadway professionals, workshop rehearsals, extracurricular activities, performances and student departure. Candidates will provide administrative assistance to the Program Coordinator, supervise Residential Mentors and assist staff, faculty, Residential Mentors, students and parents in needs that arise. This team will chaperone students to/from classes and participate in all activities in a supervisory and authoritative role. This includes intelligent decision making for the safety and well-being of the students at all times. This team will uphold and enforce all University of Texas at Austin and summer program rules and regulations as set forth in the guidelines for the summer program.

**Qualifications:** These positions require knowledge in the field of musical theatre and a strong commitment to working with young people. Candidates should be currently working towards a BFA/BA/BS with a focus on Theater Arts or a related field of study. Strong communication, leadership and problem-solving skills are a must. Experience in professional theatrical organizations in teaching or performance may be substituted.

These positions begin on or about June 6 and end on or about July 1, 2012. Residential Mentors and Residential Supervisors will be on duty and live in-residence on the UT campus day and night, during the dates of service.

**Compensation** includes a stipend, plus Room and Board during dates of service.
